

Mentis Centre for the Preservation of Traditional Textile Techniques of the Benaki Museum

The 'Mentis' Passementerie Manufactury was donated to the Benaki Museum by Spyros, Marina and Othon Mentis in 2012. It is situated at 6 Polyfimou Street in the Athenian neighborhood of Petralona. One of the oldest workshops and retailers in Greece, it specialises in fibre processing and the production of passementerie (galloons, ornamental cords, piping, braids, fringes, tassels, 'Brandebourg' frogging, curtain tiebacks). For over one-and-ahalf centuries, 'Mentis' decorated Greek traditional and theatrical costumes, clerical vestments, military uniforms and creations by famous couturiers. Today, while production continues, 'Mentis' offers visitors an opportunity to discover how a historical workshop operates and to follow each step towards processing silk and crafting masterpieces out of thread. 'Mentis' promotes the learning and preservation of traditional crafts while supporting contemporary artists.
