Rob Riemen is one of Europe's leading intellectuals. To keep the tradition of European humanism alive, he founded the journal Nexus in 1991. In 1994 he founded and currently serves as president of the Nexus Instituut, which has become one of Europe's most prestigious intellectual organizations to inspire public intellectual debate about the most important subjects for humanity and society. His most recent book, "To Fight Against This Age: On Fascism and Humanism," published by W.W. Norton early this year, consists of two beautifully written, cogent, and urgent essays about the rise of fascism and the ways in which we can combat it. Mr. Riemen's books have received critical acclaim in numerous publications, including The New York Times, The Financial Times, El País, El Mundo, El Universal, The Wall Street Journal, Gazeta Wyborcza and The Atlantic.
