The special weekend will take place at W Costa Navarino, a vibrant new resort that embodies creativity and individuality. In addition to the series of talks and book readings, Costa Navarino has curated cultural experiences for guests to enjoy, including philosophy walks with academics discussing modern-day ethics through the lens of ancient Greek philosophers, amidst the idyllic Messinian setting.
